Resolved by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the U.S. House of Representatives, that pursuant to 40 U.S.C. §3307, appropriations are authorized for repairs and alterations to upgrade building systems and undertake exterior repairs at the Denver Federal Center (DFC) Building 56 located at West 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue & Kipling Street in Lakewood, Colorado, at a design cost of \$613,000, an estimated construction cost of \$5,022,000 and a management and inspection cost of \$507,000 for a total estimated project cost of \$6,142,000, a prospectus for which is attached to and included in this resolution.

*Provided*, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
