**RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC WORKS OF  
THE UNITED STATES SENATE**

that pursuant to title 40 U.S.C. § 3307, a prospectus providing for a repair and alterations project for the James A. Byrne U.S. Courthouse (Byrne USCH), located at 601 Market St. in Philadelphia, PA, at an estimated design cost of \$7,349,000, an estimated construction cost of \$71,028,000, and an management and inspection cost of \$5,578,000, for a total cost of \$83,955,000, a prospectus for which is attached hereto and included in this resolution, is approved.

*Provided*, that the Administrator shall provide to the Chairman or Ranking Member of the Committee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate, in a timely manner, requested documents and information regarding this prospectus and resulting contractual materials, without redaction other than redactions to exclude business confidential, proprietary, and/or procurement sensitive information.

*Provided further*, that the General Services Administration shall not delegate to any other agency the authority granted by this resolution.
